





### **External Activities – supporting the ERNs:**

- Advocacy Work for the ERN / on National and European Level, for example integration into NHS
- Our presence in Eurordis WGs such as training, ethics, guidelines and in ePAG Steering Committee, which are influential roles for a developing reality

### **EURORDIS**

#### Rare Diseases Europe providing framework and direction

- Evaluating new POs
- Constitution and Terms of Reference (VASCERN now updating ToR)
- More than 1000 Patient Organisations and 300 ePAG advocates in all 24 ERNs
- 2 x training so far, one more in 2018
- Steering Committee, to mirror the BoMS and Coordination Group

### **Activity in VASCERN:**

- Building a larger network under the new concept of the ERN within the patient community for the various diseases covered in VASCERN
- Developing the VASCERN APP and in Beta Testing
- Development of patient pathways
- Development of do's and don'ts together with the clinicians
- Participation in the making of PoKs
- Participation in the transversal WGs
- Regular online meetings of the Co-Chairs and the ePAG Group
- Adapting the Terms of Reference for the VASCERN ePAG Group

- The ePAG group in VASCERN is generally considered as well developed and used as reference by EURORDIS
- We are a very strong team and in one year the relations cooperation and friendship have reached high levels
- VASCERN ePAGs have already established Terms of Reference and are working in a structured environment.
