





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VASCERN's EU co-funding projects

3rd EU Health Programme: since March 2017

Current: 3 Years Specific Grant Agreement

March 2019-February 2022

ERN Management & Coordination:

Project Team (manager, officer, assistant), Meetings (travel, hotel, rooms), Communication (webmaster, translations, scientific journal publications, app, etc.)

600k EU co-funding (60% of budget)

400k co-funding France APHP & Health ministry (40%)




Funding:

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VASCERN's Terms of Reference addition

Confidentiality Rules on the Collaborative Platform (ECP) & other platforms used (dropbox, emails...)




- Only final documents can be shared outside of the network,
 - Usually available on the website.
 - External share only if external expertise needed: patients associations, external experts.

- No patient identifying data in any form should be shared
 - The sharing of data and the protection of patient information is subject to the EU legislation on the protection of personal data (Directive 95/46/EC and General Data Protection Regulation) and to national legislation on data protection

The coordination team has the right to delete any documents that do not respect patient confidentiality rules.


VASCERN App 2.1 _ launched August 2020



Version 2.1: Improvements implemented


- Multilanguage: menu / structure and diseases are translated
- •Cards editing: only in English by default in all languages version of the mobile app, to remain accessible for all everywhere
- 35 European Reference Centers in our 30 Full HCP Members + 7 Affiliated Partners
- 66 Patient Organisations, and working with the ePAG Co-Chairs towards including all the patient organisations members of the ePAG community
- 33 Referral HCPs from France (22), The Netherlands (5), Belgium (3), Italy (2), UK (1). Need HCPs to send dataset from their national networks!

 VASCERN's Project & Coodination Team in Paris








